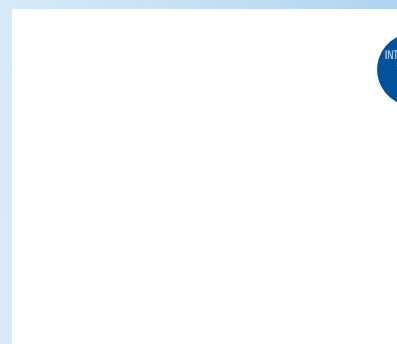
About the author

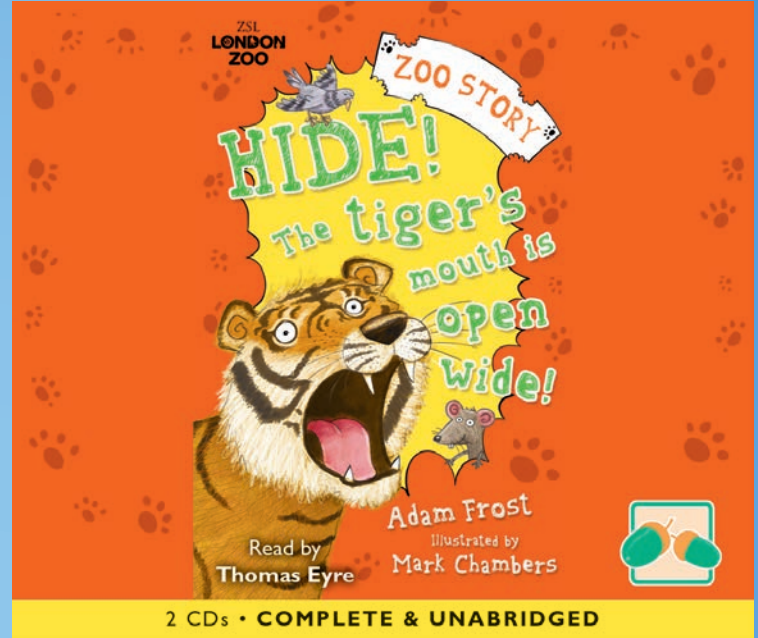
